The tree species listed below have been chosen for their ability to grow in our sandy. high acidic soils. They are a mix of native and non-native to the area species. No 'invasive' tree species are listed as they could cause environmental harm by spreading unchecked through our Pinelands environment.

With our Pine Barrens sandy soils, anytime when there is no snow on the ground is considered 'planting season'.
